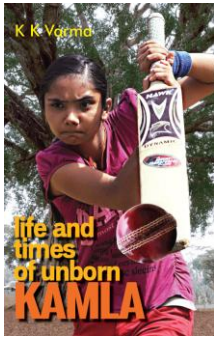


Female foeticide, trafficking subject of new book
